Limi Female Literacy Project

Overview

Limi Valley is a trans-Himalayan community located in the north-western corner of Nepal bordering Tibet. The community is known for its distinctive culture, and wildlife, and for being isolated from the rest of Nepal. Because of challenging topography and lack of transportation infrastructure, access to the region has been immensely restricted until now.

We have successfully completed our first project in Limi Valley, Humla district. Under the project name "**Ecopad Project Limi Valley Humla Nepal**", we have donated Eco-Friendly Reusable Sanitary Cloth Pads to every woman in the valley and simultaneously conducted a Menstrual Hygiene workshop for them.

During the workshop, we asked the Limi women what other types of support they require. A surprising majority showed a strong interest in learning **how to read and write**.

The women are frustrated by not being able to write their names in English or Nepali, and by having to sign official documents with their thumb impressions. The older women are interested in learning how to read Tibetan prayer scripts to be able to understand Buddhist Philosophy in depth. They are very excited at the prospect of learning how to read Tibetan prayer texts. They view this as an important opportunity to "accumulate merit" before they pass away. Their belief is that this will yield a more auspicious rebirth in their next life. And so, from several different angles, literacy will definitely increase their well-being in this life!"

Less than 10% of the female population is currently literate.

Goals

- 1. At least 80% Female Literacy in 5 years
- 2. Older women will be able to read the Tibetan Script and understand Tibetan Buddhism better
- 3. Younger women will be able to read, write, and speak in Nepali/English

Specifications

We realize that the Limi women are extremely busy with their household work, field work, and community-building work throughout the year except during winter.

So, a winter coaching session seems like the best idea. We plan to start the first phase this coming winter for three months - December, January, and February

Our plan of action: Organize classes based on the working schedule of the women and create a timetable accordingly. Conduct 2 hours of classes per day, 4 days per week; which equals **96 hours** of tutoring in three months.

Select the tutors locally from each village in order to promote employment within the village.

There are a total of **232 women** currently in Limi Valley. There are three villages namely Zang, Halji, and Til.
